1. How did the Great Famine affect the severity of the Bubonic Plague?
2. Why did Europe's population decline dramatically between 1300 and 1450?
3. Regarding the Black Death:
 - What were its causes?
 - Why did it spread so quickly throughout Western Europe?
 - Where was it most virulent?
4. How would you evaluate the status of women in the aftermath of the Black Death? How influential was misogyny in limiting women's activities and achievements?
5. How did the adversities of the 14^c affect urban life and medical practices?
6. What were the KEY social, economic and cultural consequences of the Black Death?
