2. What led to the Great Schism? Why did it prove so difficult to resolve?
3. Why did the Conciliar Movement develop in the early 15th?
4. Identify the major doctrinal reforms proposed by John Wycliffe and the Lollards and by Jan Hus and the Hussites.
5. Why was the Catholic Church losing its hold over peoples' loyalty and respect by the end of the 15th?
